## \$553M funds isle military projects

U.S. Rep. Neil Abercrombie says the 2009 National Defense Authorization Act passed by the House last week includes more than \$553 million for military construction in Hawaii. Projects for Hawaii include:

- **\$279 million:** Schofield Barracks (barracks, battalion complex, brigade complex, infrastructure)
- \$40 million: Wideband Satellite Communications Operations Center, Wahiawa
- \$9 million: Pohakuloa Training Area (Saddle Road construction)
- **\$28.9 million:** Pacific Missile Range Facility Advanced Radar Detection Laboratory
- **\$28.2 million:** Marine Corps Base Hawaii bachelor enlisted quarters (part of ongoing improvements to bachelor enlisted quarters)
- **\$80.2 million:** Naval Station Pearl Harbor (joint forces deployment staging area, fitness center, child development center)
- \$41 million: Submarine magnetic silencing facility
- **\$27.7 million:** Defense Logistics Agency; replacement of fuel pipeline at Pearl Harbor
- \$19.1 million: Army Reserve Center at Fort Shafter
