## IMPORTANT REMINDER ABOUT **MEDICARE'S NEW DRUG PLAN**



March 2006

In November, I sent you information about the new Medicare prescription drug benefit that started January 1. Since then, many Medicare beneficiaries have experienced difficulties signing Dear Friend:

While no one should feel pressured into making a quick decision, beneficiaries need to be aware of up for the program. the <u>May 15</u> deadline to sign up. After that, the earliest date to enroll is November 15, at which time seniors will be subject to a minimum seven percent penalty in their monthly premiums. For seniors who sign up even later, the penalty increases by an additional 1 percent each month. The higher premiums remain in place for the entire duration of the person's enrollment in the program.

I voted against this law based on the firm belief that the drug program is insufficient, far too complicated and designed to benefit special interests more than the seniors it is intended to help. While I will continue to work to improve the existing law and do all I can to protect and improve the Medicare program, I want you to know about the resources available to help you make a decision that is right for you.

I hope you find this information useful.

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### IMPORTANT DATES TO REMEMBER

#### May 15, 2006

Last day to enroll in a Medicare drug plan without incurring a 1 percent per month premium surcharge and last day to enroll to receive any benefits in 2006.

#### November 15, 2006

The open enrollment period for Medicare Drug Benefit (Part D) begins for 2007. This is also the first opportunity for those who enrolled in a Medicare drug plan for 2006 to switch plans if they wish.
