## Shuster Joins Colleagues to Demand Immediate Action to Pass Real Energy Reforms

Only Three Weeks Left for House to Vote on the "American Energy Act"

Washington, D.C. – Today, Congressman Bill Shuster joined his Republican colleagues in calling on Speaker Pelosi to stop stonewalling and bring the "American Energy Act" up for a vote.

"Over the August recess, I added my voice to the Republican energy protest on the House floor where we took the Republican message of an all-of-the-above American energy policy directly to the people.
