- 1- **Application Form:** Complete the application form and attach a recent photograph. Please mail all completed forms and letters to the **Augusta District Office**. It is the responsibility of each candidate to verify that their file is complete prior to the deadline. Each candidate **must** have initiated a file with each service academy to which they are seeking a nomination.
- 2- **Letters of Recommendation-** Please provide **three** letters of recommendation from *non-family members* **who know you personally** and can attest to your character, work ethic, and leadership skills. Suggested references include: guidance counselors, teachers, coaches, employers, church leaders, scout leaders, and family friends.
- 3- **Academic Information**: Please provide an **official** transcript of your academic record from your high school and college (if applicable) to include your attendance and discipline records.
- 4- **Standardized Test Scores** Please include a copy of your SAT and or ACT scores. Consider retaking SAT/ACT to improve scores.
- 5- Extracurricular Activities/Honors and Awards- (limit to one page) Please list athletic and non-athletic extracurricular activities to include leadership positions held. Please include significant honors or awards which you have received.
- 6- **Personal Statement-** in 300 words or less, explain your reasons for wanting to become an officer in our country's military service and what you have done specifically to prepare yourself for this goal.
- 7- Deadline- The deadline for receiving the completed application *package* is 5:00 PM on October 31, 2008. Required attachments and recommendation letters may be mailed separately. Send all requested information to:
