As U.S. Prices Continue to Increase, Seniors Look Elsewhere for Their Pharmaceutical Prescription Drugs

Dear Colleague:

Currently, American consumers pay as much as 5 or 6 times more for their prescription drugs than citizens in Canada, Germany, and many other industrialized parts of the world. For instance, women who are suffering from breast cancer and are taking Tomoxifen to save their lives pay \$134 for a 30-day supply in my home state of Indiana, while in Germany the cost is just \$60, and in Canada the cost is as low as \$33 for the very same product. Not only is that outrageous, it is just plain wrong.

I would like to commend your personal attention to the attached article from yesterday's edition of *USA Today*, entitled "*Once just a trickle, Canada's Rx drugs pouring into USA*," written by William M. Welch. This article does an excellent job of explaining why it is critical for Members of Congress to work together with the pharmaceutical industry to finally bring fair pricing to the worldwide prescription drug market. In addition to the attached article, I am displaying a chart that illustrates the price disparity of commonly purchased drugs in the U.S. and Canada.
