Congressman Mario Diaz-Balart Ridicules Democrats' Baseless Election Challenge

Diaz-Balart: Should the Orange Bowl Result Be Overturned Too?

WASHINGTON—Congressman Mario Diaz-Balart (R-Fla.) today ridiculed the Democrats' baseless challenge to Ohio's election results.

"Perhaps Oklahoma should follow the Democrats' lead and petition the NCAA to overturn the Orange Bowl result, too," Diaz-Balart said. "President Bush won Ohio, period. Just because the Democrats don't like the results does not mean the results aren't correct.
