House Moves to Stick Taxpayers With \$3.6 Billion Bill for a Day's Work

House Authorizes \$3.6 Billion in Spending on Same Day Administration Announces Record Deficit

Mesa, Arizona - Arizona Congressman Jeff Flake, who represents the state's Sixth District, today scolded the House of Representatives for authorizing \$3.6 billion in spending over five years during the 24 hours they were in session this week.

Ironically, this spending spree came the same day the Bush Administration announced a record \$374.2 billion deficit for fiscal year 2003. Even more disappointing, this spending was passed by voice vote without giving Members a chance to vote on record.

"In light of the House's spending spree this week, I think the old adage 'another day, another dollar' might have to be updated," said Flake. "However, I don't know that taxpayers are going to like the sound of 'another day, another 3.6 billion dollars."

"The sad truth is that Congress seems to have abandoned all efforts at fiscal restraint."
