

Sam Johnson: Thank God we didn't have those Democrats at the Alamo! Calls Texas Democrats 'Deserters'

This morning on the floor of the U.S. House of Representatives, U.S. Congressman Sam Johnson (3rd Dist.-Texas) blasted Texas Democrats of the State House for abandoning their posts.
