Congresswoman Comments On Supreme Court Decision

"The compromise decision today by the Supreme Court to continue allowing racial preference under the guise of a "critical mass" admission policy is still an unfair reward. There is no compelling interest for a state to allow its taxpayer-financed institutions, such as the University of Michigan, to promote such preferences. The American people agree and it is unfortunate additional justices did not concur. After all, we really should be living in a color blind society, as so many activists are seeking."
