I am requesting \$12 million in FY09 Science & Technology funding from the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) Appropriations Bill for the Critical Infrastructure Decision-making Exercises (DECIDE) project.

The entity to receive the funding is the DHS, which in turn works with the Cyber Conflict Research Consortium (CCRC) on this project. The CCRC is an affiliation of academic institutions, including Miami University, Norwich University Applied Research Institutes, Potomac Institute for Policy Studies, University of Nevada Reno, and Utah State University Spaced Research Foundation. The consortium is headed-up by Norwich University Applied Research Institutes located at 57 Old Freight Yard, P.O. Box 30, Northfield, Vermont 05663-0030. The funding would be used to continue work begun with DHS in FY08 on DECIDE technology, including development of core software components, and prototype demonstration to various federal and corporate financial institutions concerned about the growing dangers of cyber attacks on financial data bases.




