

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE
NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 840
OFFERED BY MRS. BIGGERT OF ILLINOIS AND
MR. DAVIS OF KENTUCKY**

Page 4 of the amendment, line 13, strike "and".

Page 5 of the amendment, line 23, strike the period
and insert "; and".

Page 5 of the amendment, after line 23 insert the
following:

1 “(6)(A) a child or youth who has been verified
2 as homeless, as such term is defined in section
3 725(2)(B)(i) of the McKinney-Vento Homeless As-
4 sistance Act (42 U.S.C. 11434a(2)(B)(ii)), by a local
5 educational agency homeless liaison, designated pur-
6 suant to section 722(g)(1)(J)(ii) of the McKinney-
7 Vento Homeless Assistance Act (42 U.S.C.
8 11432(g)(1)(J)(ii)), and the family of such child or
9 youth;

10 “(B) a youth verified as homeless by the direc-
11 tor of a program funded under the Runaway and
12 Homeless Youth Act (42 U.S.C. 5701 et seq.), or a
13 designee of the director;

1 “(C) a child verified as homeless under section
2 602 of the Individuals with Disabilities Education
3 Act (20 U.S.C. 1401) by the director or the designee
4 of such program, and the family of such child; and
5 “(D) a child verified as homeless under section
6 637 of the Head Start Act (42 U.S.C. 9832) by the
7 director or designee of such program, and the family
8 of such child.”.

Page 6, line 6, after “situation,” insert “including situations where the health and safety of children and youth are jeopardized,”.

Page 51, strike lines 15 through 25.

Strike line 1 on page 52 and all that follows through page 53, line 5.
