Tactics of Palestinian Terrorism

In response to the usual requests for updates, the RSC continues to compile a *partial* list of the tactics used in Palestinian terrorism that resulted in the death of innocents. Since the late Yasser Arafat "renounced" violence in the Oslo Peace Accords on September 13, 1993, at least 53 American citizens, including women and children, have been murdered by Palestinian terrorists and at least another 83 Americans have been injured by such terrorists. 1,041 people of various nationalities have been killed by Palestinian terrorism just since September 2000.

Remote-detonated bombing in a service taxi:

March 1, 2001

Remote-detonated bombing involving a military vehicle:

June 22, 2001; September 5, 2002; May 11, 2004

Remote-detonated bombing in a university facility:

July 31, 2002

Remote-detonated bombing in a tunnel:

June 27, 2004; **December 12, 2004**

Remote-detonated bombing at a resort:

October 7, 2004

Remote-detonated bombing at a construction site:

October 21, 2004

Booby-trap bombing at an agricultural site:

December 7, 2004

Bicycle-bombing attack:

November 11, 1994

Driving a bus into a crowd of people:

February 14, 2001

Shooting citizens at their own homes:

April 27, 2002; June 8, 2002; June 20, 2002; August 10, 2002; November 10, 2002; January 17, 2003; March 7, 2003; September 26, 2003; April 3, 2004; August 13, 2004

Shooting students on the playground:

May 28, 2002

Shooting civilian drivers of moving cars:

March 19, 2003; May 5, 2003; June 12, 2003; June 17, 2003; June 20, 2003; June 30, 2003; August 29, 2003; January 13, 2004; July 4, 2004

Attack with a mine:

November 9, 2002; February 15, 2003

Attack with grenades:

November 15, 2002; November 28, 2002; December 22, 2003

Attack with a rocket:

May 12, 2004; June 28, 2004; September 24, 2004; October 28, 2004; December 14, 2004

NOTE: These tactics are in addition to the <u>innumerable</u> instances of gunfire, kidnapping, stabbing, stoning, and other such acts of Palestinian terrorists.
