




# Deficit/Surplus Under Budget Resolution




### Debt Under Budget Resolution



## Comparison of Spending Under Resolution and President's Budget





### **Budget Resolution Provides Up to** \$50 Billion for SCHIP Over Five Years



(Education funding in 2008, \$ in billions)






# Revenues in Budget Resolution

- Includes no tax increase


## Comparison of Revenues Under Resolution and President's Budget

## AMT Relief for Two Years (with cost offset)








