





### Debt Under Budget Resolution


### Spending Under Budget Resolution

#### Budget Resolution Only Slightly Above Baseline for Nondefense Discretionary Funding


(Nondefense discretionary BA, excluding emergencies; \$ in billions)

#### **Budget Resolution Provides Up to** \$50 Billion for SCHIP Over Five Years



(Education funding in 2008, \$ in billions)






#### Budget Resolution Provides \$3.5 Billion More Than Bush Budget for Veterans


### AMT Relief for Two Years (with cost offset)






### Comparison of Revenues Under Resolution and President's Budget
