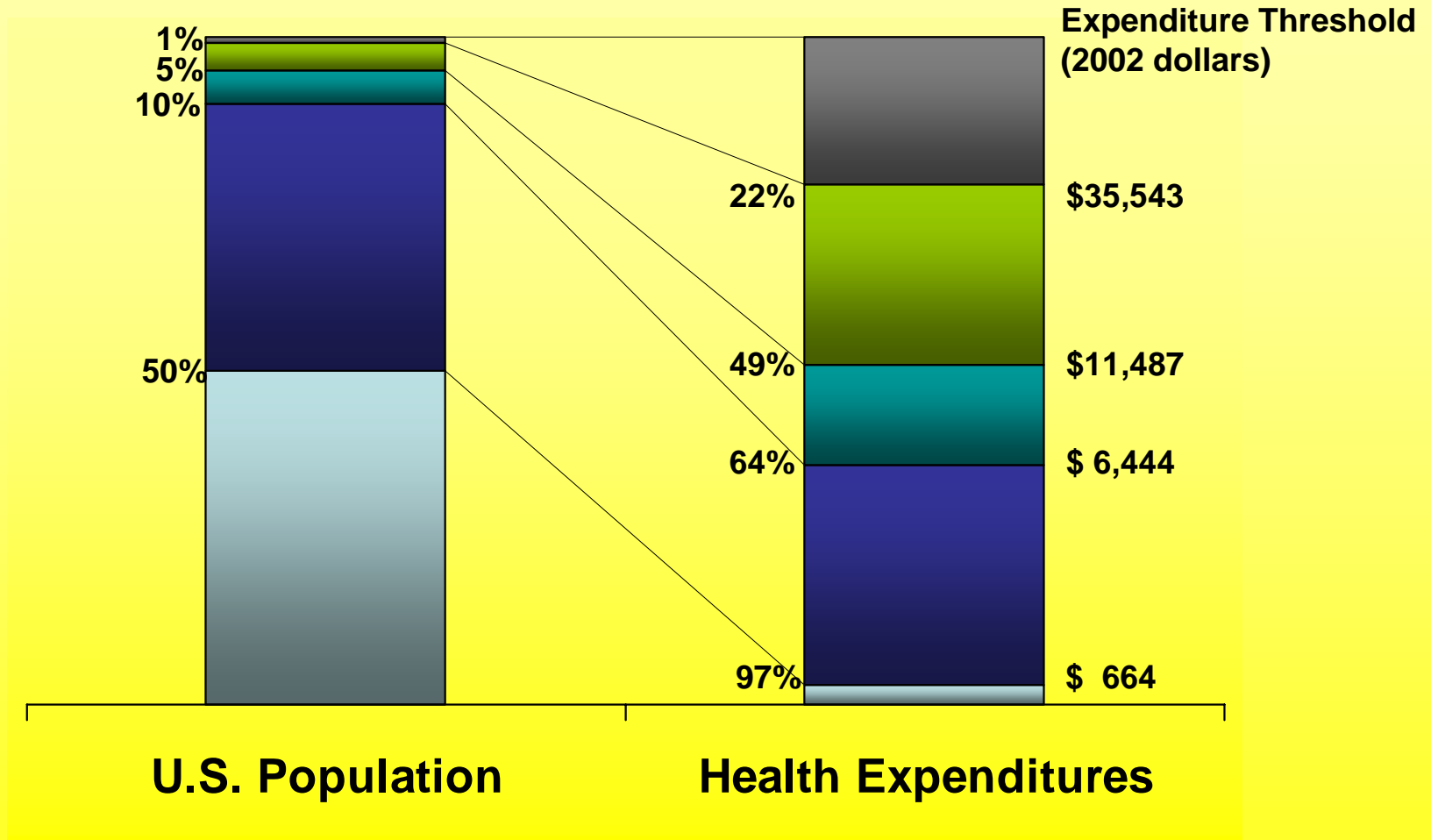


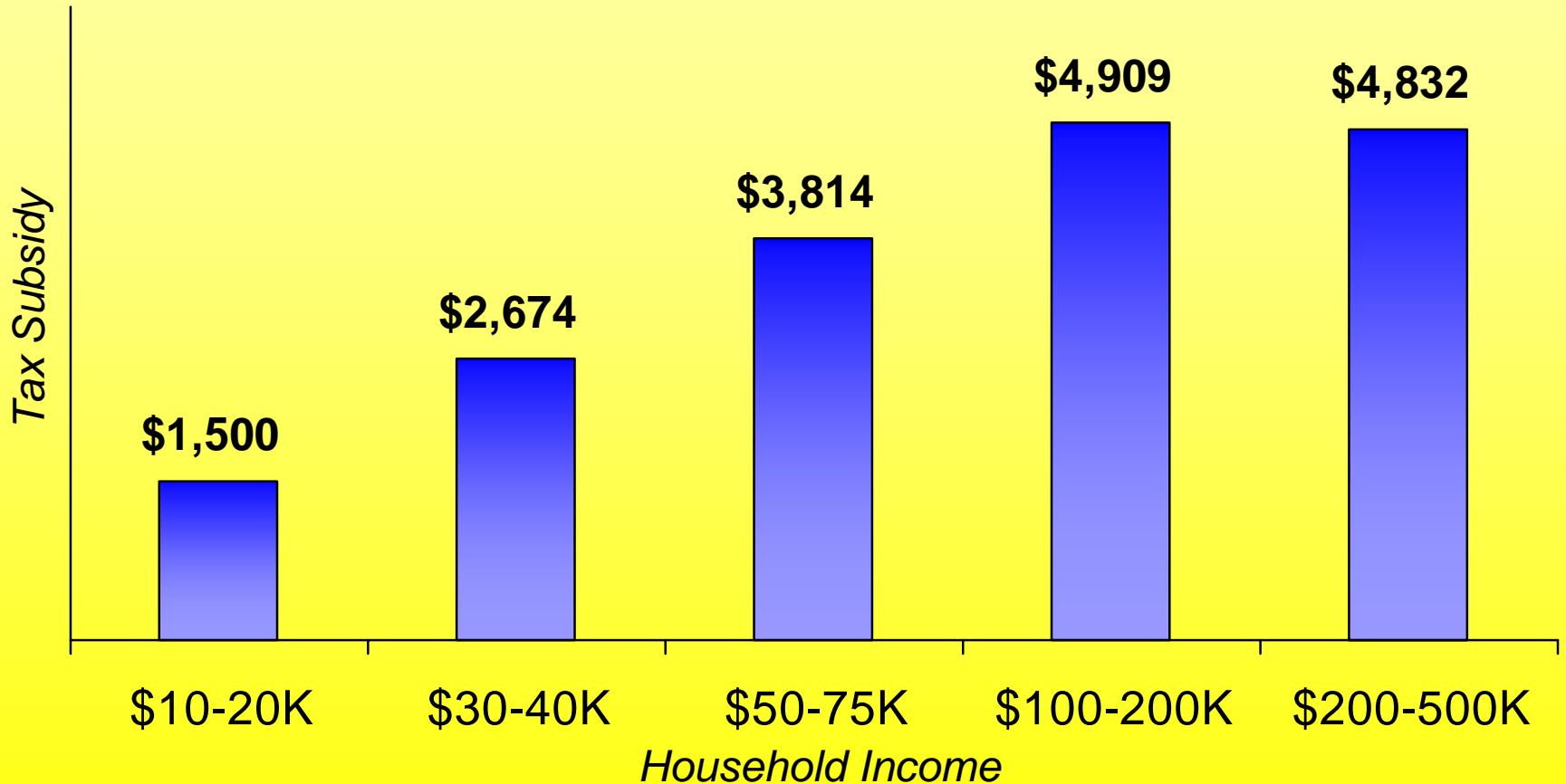
Health Care Costs Concentrated in Sick Few

10% of the Population Accounts for 64% of Health Spending

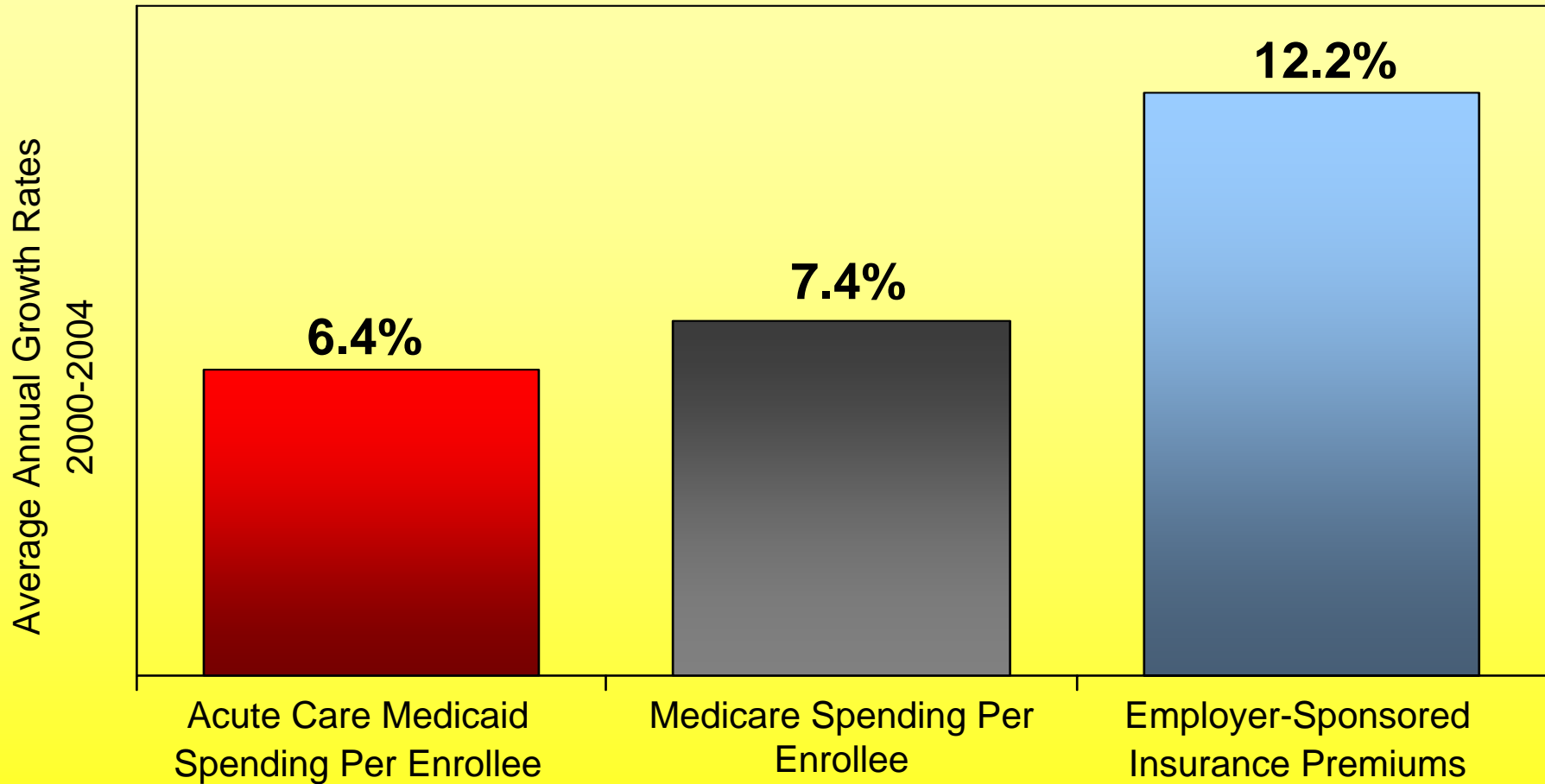


President's Health Deduction: Smallest Subsidies for Those Least Able to Afford Insurance

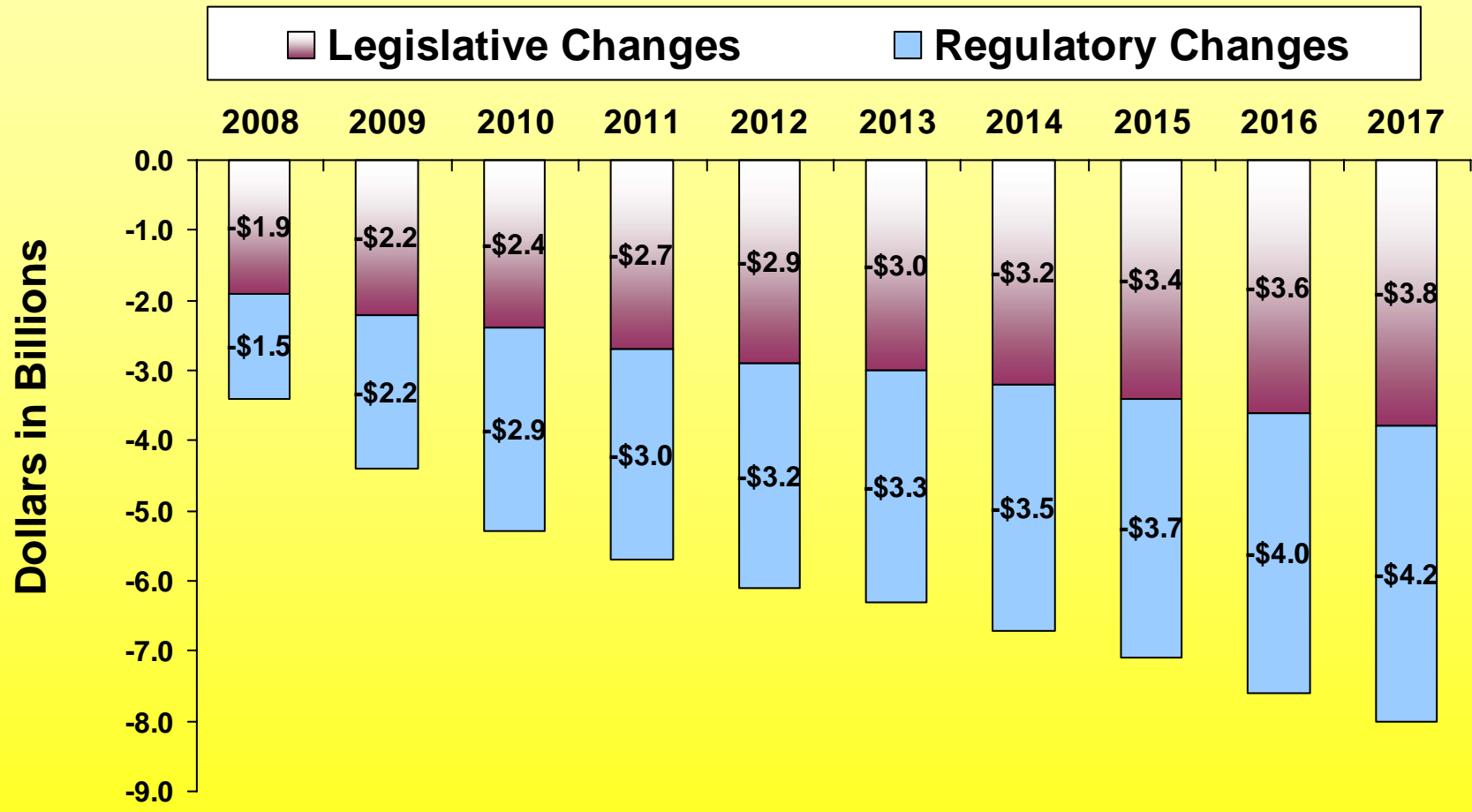
Average Tax Subsidy by Income Group



Medicaid and Medicare Expenditures Per Person Have Grown More Slowly Than Private Insurance Premiums

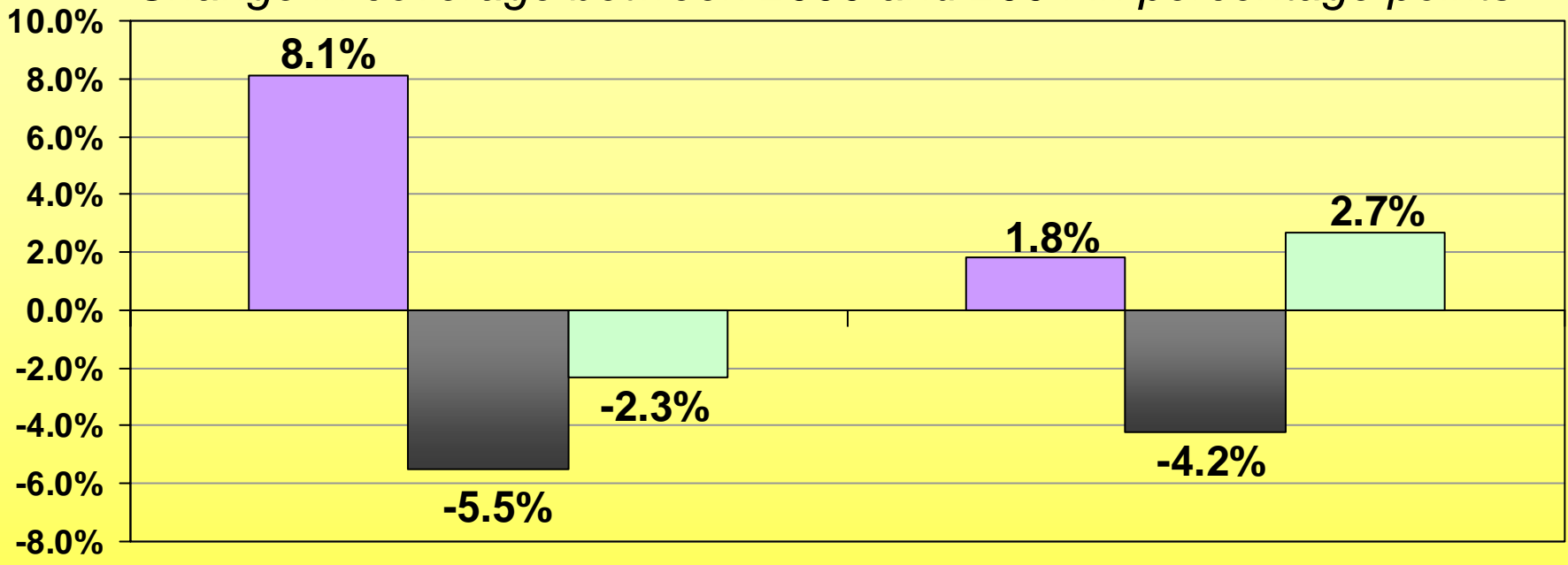


Gross Cuts to Medicaid of \$60.5 Billion Over Ten Years
