Discussion

1. What is management doing to protect us?

Steve Redisch: We don't want to do what many of the governments whose countries we broadcast do, that is, take away someone's freedom of expression. Let our work speak for itself.

Donna Grace: Don't self censor yourself. You are all doing the right things. VOA management does not lend credence to recent blog attacks against PNN and its leadership or believe what they say.

Barbara Brady: VOA general counsel is fully aware of all communication and attacks on the Persian News Network. They are taking steps to protect the agency.

2. What can we do about blogs that attack our work and the people who support them who work at VOA? Steve Redisch: Blogs that discuss our work are a symbol of our success. We enjoy freedom of speech in America. However, I will not stand for people at VOA who undermine our mission.
