- H.R. 3988 To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 3701 Altamesa Boulevard in Fort Worth, Texas, as the "Master Sergeant Kenneth N. Mack Post Office Building" (*Rep. Granger - Oversight and Government Reform*)
- 2) <u>H.R. 4211</u> To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 725 Roanoke Avenue in Roanoke Rapids, North Carolina, as the "Judge Richard B. Allsbrook Post Office" (*Rep. Butterfield - Oversight and Government Reform*)
- 3) <u>H.R. 3720</u> To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 424 Clay Avenue in Waco, Texas, as the "Army PFC Juan Alonso Covarrubias Post Office Building" (*Rep. Edwards – Oversight and Government Reform*)
- 4) <u>H.Con.Res. 198</u> Expressing the sense of Congress that the United States has a moral responsibility to meet the needs of those persons, groups and communities that are impoverished, disadvantaged or otherwise in poverty (*Rep. Lee Oversight and Government Reform*)
- 5) <u>H.R. 409</u> To amend title 23, United States Code, to inspect highway tunnels (*Rep. Capuano Transportation and Infrastructure*)
- 6) <u>H.Res. 772</u> Recognizing the American Highway Users Alliance on the occasion of its 75th anniversary, and for other purposes (*Rep. Oberstar Transportation and Infrastructure*)
- 7) <u>H.Res. 866</u> Honoring the brave men and women of the United States Coast Guard whose tireless work, dedication, and commitment to protecting the United States have led to the Coast Guard seizing over 350,000 pounds of cocaine at sea during 2007, far surpassing all of our previous records (*Rep. Coble Transportation and Infrastructure*)
- 8) H.R. 3432 -Commission on the Abolition of the Transatlantic Slave Trade Act, as amended by the Senate (*Rep. Payne Foreign Affairs*)
