- 1. These two events will attract an estimated 148,000 attendees and \$55 million in economic impact.
- 2. The SEC was the first conference in the NCAA to hold a championship game in football.
- 3. The Chick-fil-A Bowl leads all other bowl games in charitable contributions, giving more than \$1 million to organizations in 2007 alone.
