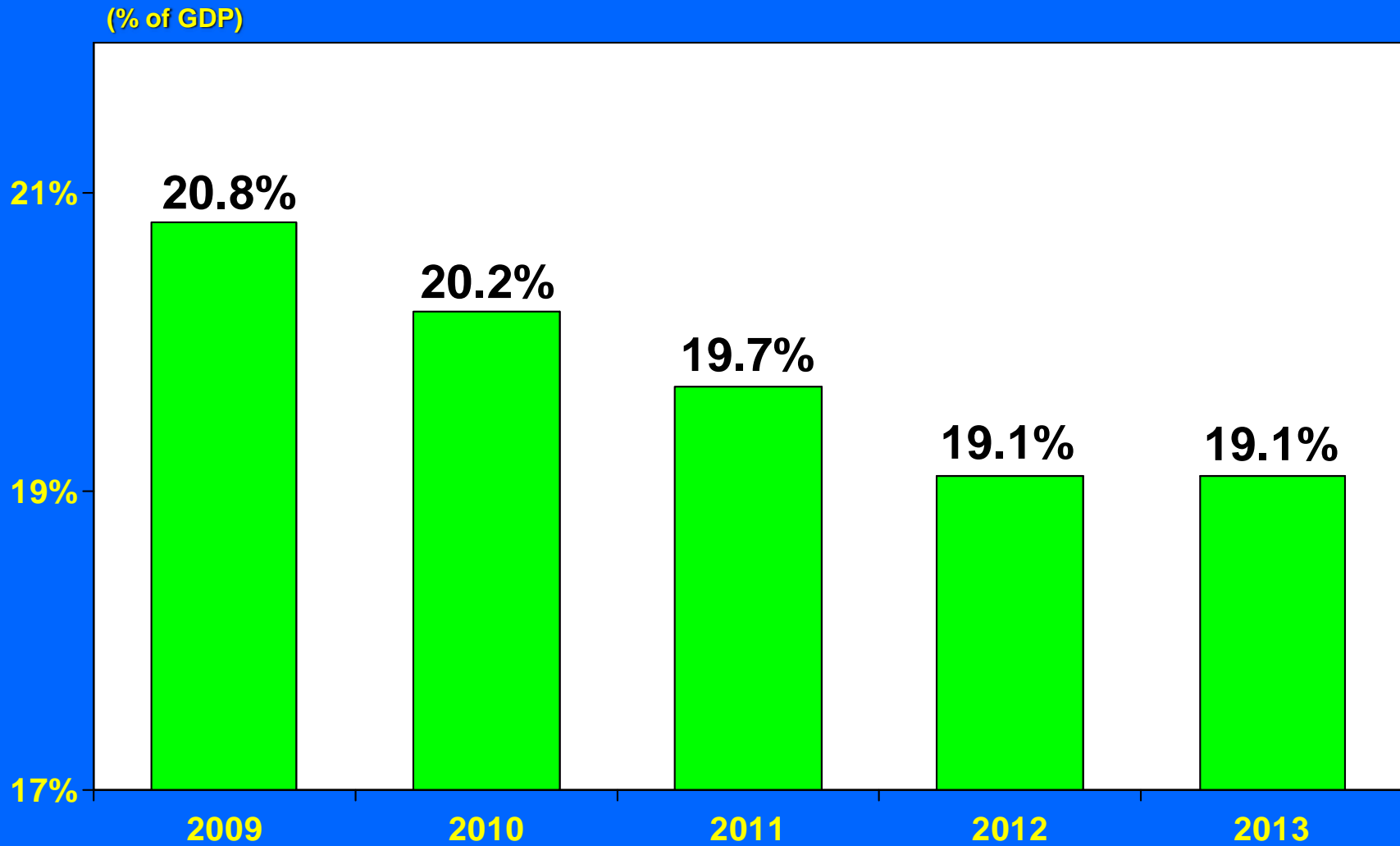
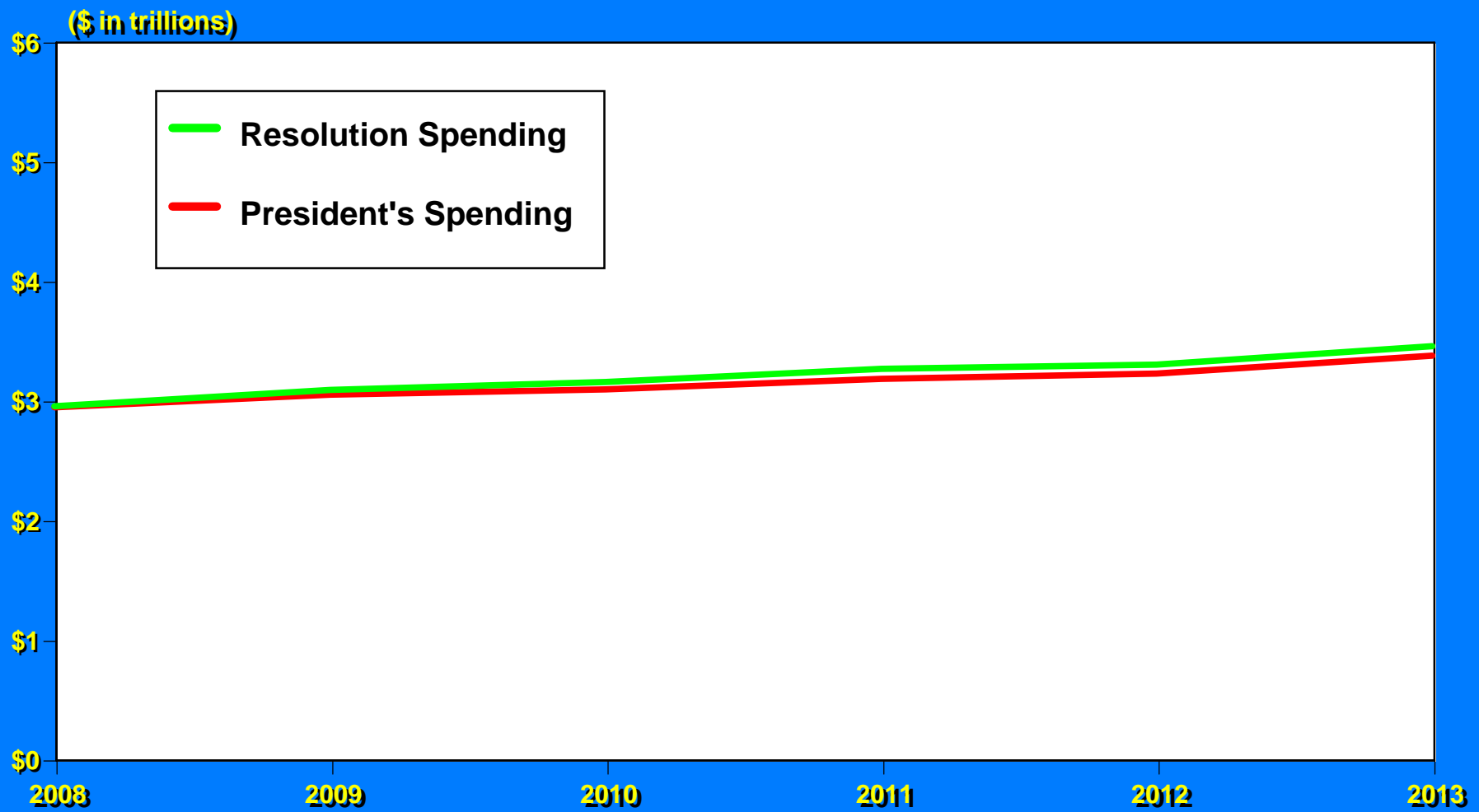

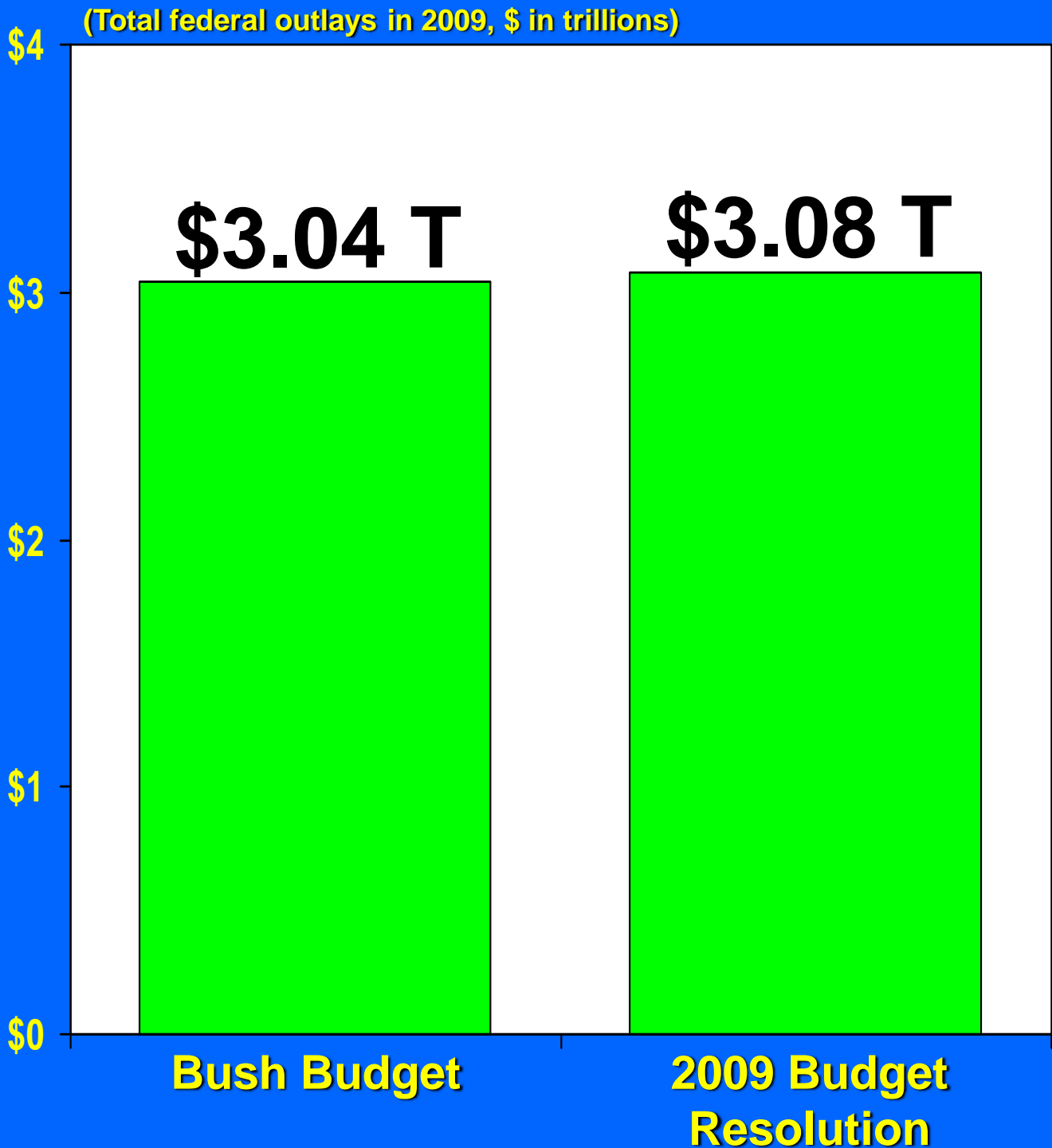

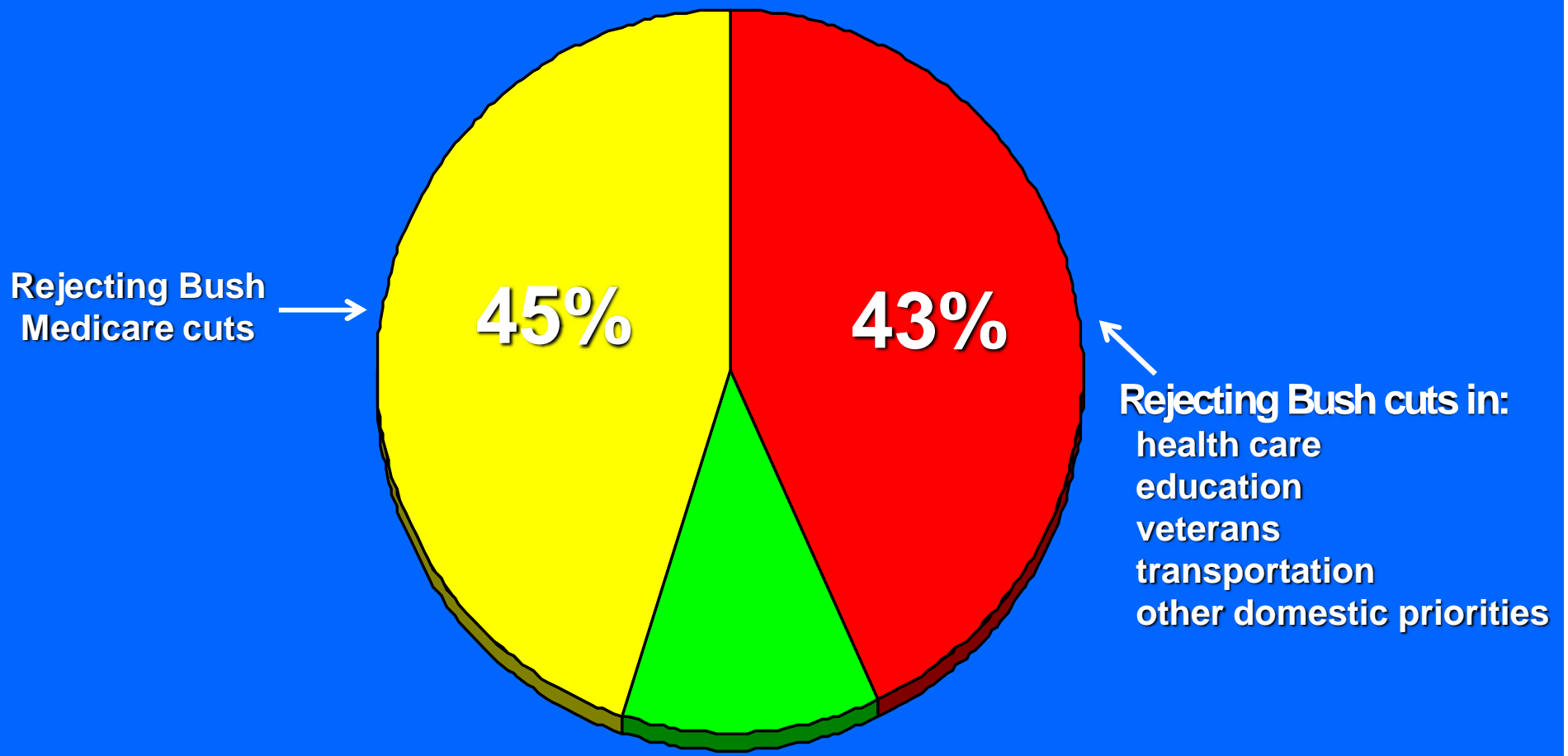
Budget Resolution Includes Only 1% More Spending Than Bush Budget in 2009

President Proposes Deep Cuts in Key Priorities

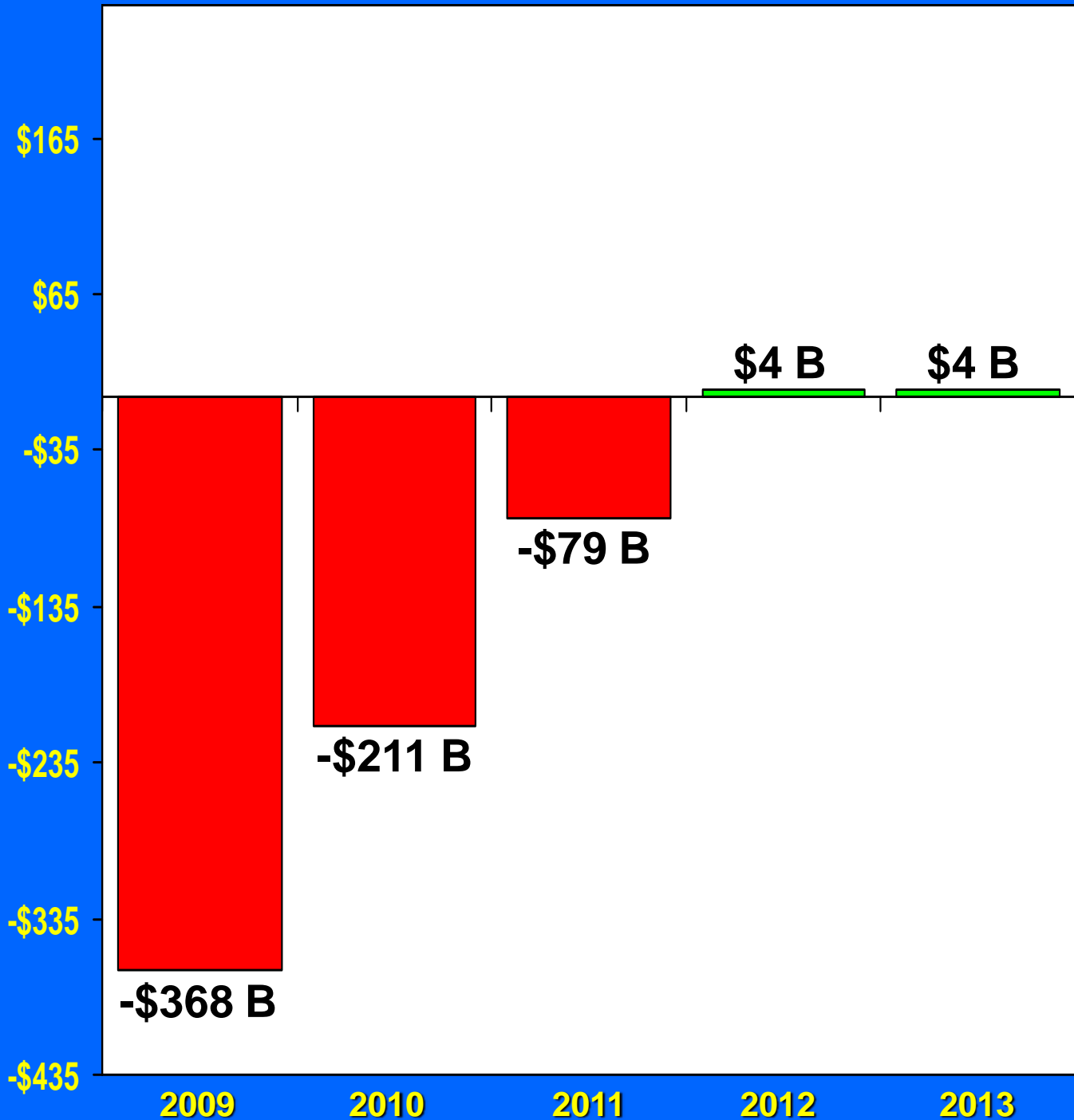

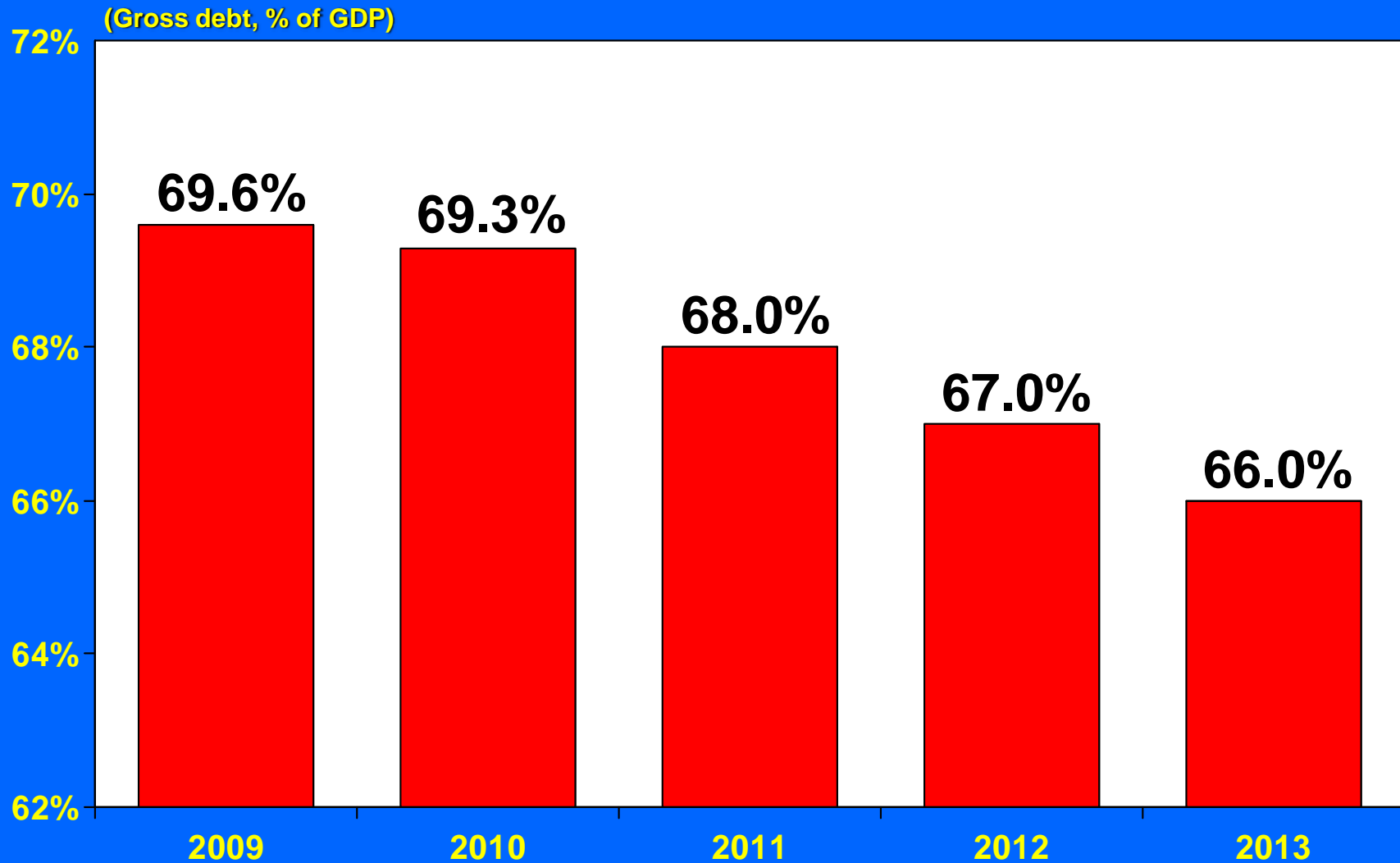
Deficit/Surplus Under Budget Resolution
