## **Assistance with Federal Agencies**

If you have a concern regarding Social Security, IRS, Passports, Immigration, Veterans Issues, Medicare, Military Cases, HUD, USDA, or any other federal agency, please feel free to contact one of our constituent services representatives in any of our Tenth District Offices.



## **Flags & Tourist Attractions**

Our office provides a comprehensive list of museums, attractions and tours in the Washington area. Please contact the Washington office if you'd like to purchase an American Flag that has flown over the U.S. Capitol or if you have any further tourism questions.



## **United States Capitol Tours**

If you would like to see the House or Senate Chambers, gallery passes are available from the Washington office. In order to arrange a tour of the Capitol, please contact the Washington office and indicate the dates you will be visiting. Please make request four to six weeks in advance.



## **Federal Grants**

Members of Congress receive numerous requests for sources of funding support for individual and community projects. In order to find the most appropriate places to apply, grant seekers need to explore all potential funding sources before writing proposals. I can provide you with grant application information and assistance by contacting the Austin office.



## **Military Academies**

An individual interested in attending one of our Military Service Academies must meet the admissions requirements and receive a Congressional nomination. Interested applicants should contact the Austin office for further information.



## **Internships**

Congressional internships are available in all of our offices. To be considered for an intern position, please forward a letter of intent with a resume to the Washington or Austin office.
