AMENDMENT intended to be proposed by Mrs. CLINTON

Viz:

1 At the end of subtitle A of title XII, add the fol-
2 lowing:

3 **SEC. 1209. REPORTS ON IMPLEMENTATION OF THE**
4 **DARFUR PEACE AGREEMENT.**

5 (a) REQUIREMENT FOR REPORTS.—Not later than
6 30 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, and
7 every 60 days thereafter until the date that the President
8 submits the certification described in subsection (b), the

1 President shall submit to Congress a report on the imple-
2 mentation of the Darfur Peace Agreement of May 5, 2006,
3 and the situation in Darfur, Sudan. Each such report shall
4 include—

5 (1) a description of the steps being taken by the
6 Government of Sudan, the Sudan Liberation Move-
7 ment/Army (SLM/A), and other parties to the
8 Agreement to uphold their commitments to—

9 (A) demobilize and disarm the Janjaweed,
10 as stated in paragraphs 214(F), 338, 339, 340,
11 366, 387, and 368 of the Agreement;

12 (B) provide secure, unfettered access for
13 humanitarian personnel and supplies, as stated
14 in paragraph 214(E) of the Agreement;

15 (C) ensure that foreign combatants respect
16 the provisions of the Agreement, as stated in
17 paragraphs 341 through 344 of the Agreement;
18 and

19 (D) expedite the safe and voluntary return
20 of internally-displaced persons and refugees to
21 their places of origin, as stated in paragraphs
22 182 through 187 of the Agreement;

23 (2) a description of any violation of the Agree-
24 ment and any delay in implementing the Agreement,
25 including any such violation or delay that com-

1 promises the safety of civilians, and the names of
2 the individuals or entities responsible for such viola-
3 tion or delay;

4 (3) a description of any attacks against civilians
5 and any activities that disrupt implementation of the
6 Agreement by armed persons who are not a party to
7 the Agreement; and

8 (4) a description of the ability of the Ceasefire
9 Commission, the African Union Mission in Sudan,
10 and the other organizations identified in the Agree-
11 ment to monitor the implementation of the Agree-
12 ment, and a description of any obstruction to such
13 monitoring.

14 (b) CERTIFICATION.—The certification described in
15 this subsection is a certification made by the President
16 and submitted to Congress that the Government of Sudan
17 has fulfilled its obligations under the Darfur Peace Agree-
18 ment of May 5, 2006, to demobilize and disarm the
19 Janjaweed and to protect civilians.

20 (c) FORM AND AVAILABILITY OF REPORTS.—

21 (1) FORM.—A report submitted under this sec-
22 tion shall be in an unclassified form and may include
23 a classified annex.

1 (2) AVAILABILITY.—The President shall make
2 the unclassified portion of a reported submitted
3 under this section available to the public.
