## *Unemployment Insurance, Benefits, and Services*

### Unemployment Insurance

<b>Administrator</b>	Wisconsin Department of Workforce Development
<b>Description</b>	Unemployment Insurance (UI) provides temporary unemployment benefits to eligible workers that have lost their job through no fault of their own. The individual must also be currently seeking employment, in approved training, or awaiting recall to employment. In Wisconsin, some workers may be eligible for an extension of unemployment benefits under the federal emergency unemployment compensation (EUC). This provides up to 34 weeks of unemployment compensation. Because of the current economic situation in Wisconsin, Wisconsin also qualifies for an additional 13 weeks of unemployment benefits for a total of 47 weeks of emergency unemployment compensation. There is also Extended Benefits (EB) when EUC is exhausted. Extended Benefits offers 13 more weeks of unemployment and an additional 7 when Wisconsin is in a period of high unemployment. ### COBRA Continuation Coverage

<b>Description</b>	COBRA allows for continued health care coverage after the loss of employment. If the employer continues to offer a group health plan, the employee can retain health insurance for up to 18 months by paying group rates. Eligible individuals pay only 35 percent of their COBRA premiums and the remaining 65 percent is reimbursed to the coverage provider through a tax credit. To qualify, individuals must experience a COBRA qualifying event that is the involuntary termination of a covered employee's employment.

Heating system assistance includes payment for repairs, or in some situations your residence may qualify for a total replacement of a non-operating furnace or boiler.</p>
