At the end of title III, add the following:

1 **SEC. 308. COMMUNICATION BETWEEN GOVERNMENT AGEN-**  
 2 **CIES AND THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND**  
 3 **SECURITY.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 642 of the Illegal Immi-  
 5 gration Reform and Immigrant Responsibility Act of 1996  
 6 (8 U.S.C. 1373) is amended—

7 (1) by striking “Immigration and Naturaliza-  
 8 tion Service” and inserting “Department of Home-  
 9 land Security” each place it appears; and

10 (2) by adding at the end the following:

11 “(d) ENFORCEMENT.—

12 “(1) INELIGIBILITY FOR FEDERAL LAW EN-  
 13 FORCEMENT AID.—Upon a determination that any  
 14 person, or any Federal, State, or local government  
 15 agency or entity, is in violation of subsection (a) or  
 16 (b), the Attorney General shall not provide to that  
 17 person, agency, or entity any grant amount pursuant  
 18 to any law enforcement grant program carried out  
 19 by any element of the Department of Justice, includ-  
 20 ing the program under section 241(i) of the Immi-



1       gration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 241(i)), and  
2       shall ensure that no such grant amounts are pro-  
3       vided, directly or indirectly, to such person, agency,  
4       or entity. In the case of grant amounts that other-  
5       wise would be provided to such person, agency, or  
6       entity pursuant to a formula, such amounts shall be  
7       reallocated among eligible recipients.

8               “(2) VIOLATIONS BY GOVERNMENT OFFI-  
9       CIALS.—In any case in which a Federal, State, or  
10       local government official is in violation of subsection  
11       (a) or (b), the government agency or entity that em-  
12       ploys (or, at the time of the violation, employed) the  
13       official shall be subject to the sanction under para-  
14       graph (1).

15               “(3) DURATION.—The sanction under para-  
16       graph (1) shall remain in effect until the Attorney  
17       General determines that the person, agency, or enti-  
18       ty has ceased violating subsections (a) and (b).”.

19               “(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by  
20       subsection (a) shall apply to grant requests pending on  
21       or or after the date of the enactment of this Act.
