Thank you very much for all of the hard work that you and your staff have put into crafting the *Improving Nutrition for America's Children Act (H.R. 5504)*. We congratulate you and the Committee on this excellent bill, and particularly thank you for including \$50 million in mandatory funding for Farm to School initiatives.

The Community Food Security Coalition (CFSC) strongly supports Farm to School programs as a responsible, cost effective means to improving child nutrition while simultaneously stimulating rural farm economies. In these challenging economic times, we appreciate that every dollar must be examined for its effectiveness. By investing in farm to school programs, you have provided an opportunity to feed school children more healthfully by enhancing existing nutrition programs, while at the same time cultivating new markets for farmers and stimulating rural economies.
