## AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 3999 OFFERED BY MR. FLAKE OF ARIZONA

At the end of the bill, add the following:

SEC. 7. FLEXIBILITY FOR STATES WITH STRUCTURALLY DE FICIENT BRIDGES.
Section 117 of title 23, United States Code, is
amended—
(1) by redesignating the second subsection (c)
and subsections (d), (e), (f), (g), and (h) as sub-

sections (d), (e), (f), (g), (h), and (i), respectivelyand

(2) by adding at the end the following:

10 "(j) SPECIAL RULE FOR STATES WITH STRUC-TURALLY DEFICIENT BRIDGES.—Notwithstanding any 11 12 other provision of this section, if, on the date of enactment 13 of this subsection, a State has within its boundaries a 14 structurally deficient bridge, that State may obligate all or any portion of the funds made available, before, on, 15 16 or after such date of enactment and any associated obligation limitation, to carry out a project described in section 17 18 1702 of Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity: A Legacy for Users (119 Stat. 1256), a 19

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1 transportation project described in title I of division K of

2 the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2008 (Public Law

3 110–161), or for any other project to repair or replace

4 a structurally deficient bridge in such State.".
