

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 6052, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MS. SHEA-PORTER OF NEW
HAMPSHIRE**

At the end of the bill, add the following:

1 **SEC. 8. STUDIES RELATING TO PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION.**

2 (a) PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION SOLUTIONS FOR
3 RURAL AND SUBURBAN COMMUNITIES.—

4 (1) STUDY.—The Secretary of Transportation,
5 in consultation with the Secretary of Energy, shall
6 conduct a study of the most energy-efficient and
7 cost-effective public transportation solutions for
8 rural and suburban communities, including transpor-
9 tation systems that primarily serve to connect a sub-
10 urban or rural community to an urban center.

11 (2) REPORT.—Not later than one year after the
12 date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall
13 submit to Congress a report on the results of the
14 study.

15 (b) COORDINATION OF PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION
16 PLANNING WITH DEVELOPMENT OF LOW-INCOME AND
17 AFFORDABLE HOUSING.—

18 (1) STUDY.—The Secretary of Transportation,
19 in consultation with the Secretary of Housing and

1 Urban Development, shall conduct a study to as-
2 sess—

3 (A) the costs and benefits of coordinating
4 public transportation planning with the develop-
5 ment of low-income and affordable housing; and

6 (B) the impact of the availability of public
7 transportation systems on these housing devel-
8 opments and their residents.

9 (2) REPORT.—Not later than one year after the
10 date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall
11 submit to Congress a report on the results of the
12 study.
