Inglis To Hold Several Town Hall Meetings Beginning Monday

Fourth District Congressman Bob Inglis will be touring Greenville and Spartanburg counties this week as he prepares to hold the first of several town hall meetings.

Inglis, who has served the Fourth Congressional District since 2005, will hold the first meeting Monday night at 7 pm at Mauldin City Hall, located at 5 East Butler Road, in Mauldin. Among the topics expected to be discussed are health care reform and economic issues, just two of the more significant issues plaguing Americans presently.

Inglis will also hold a town hall meeting Tuesday night at 6:30 at the Cowpens Library, located at 181 School Street, in Cowpens and in Boiling Springs on Wednesday at 7 pm at the Upstate Family Resource Center, located at 1850 Old Furnace Road.

Inglis will also walk neighborhoods in the areas of the town hall meeting for a few hours beforehand and will be available, along with other staff members, 30 minutes prior to the meetings to assist constituents needing help with federal agencies. However, healthcare reform and economic issues are the likely subjects that will be addressed as Inglis wants to weigh the feedback from constituents before congress reconvenes in September.
