The Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs held a business meeting at 10 a.m. on Wednesday, September 17, 2008, in SD-342, which continued at 4:45 p.m. (in conjunction with the first vote) on Tuesday, September 23, 2008, in S-216 (off the floor).

1. **S. 3474, Federal Information Security Management Act (FISMA) of 2008**

Results: Ordered reported favorably en bloc by voice vote.
