# GRANT APPLICATION NOTICE

- Published in Federal Register
  - Accessible via web
- Typically includes link to application package
- Application package contains all vital info
  - Selection criteria
  - Competitive priorities
  - Contact information for program office
  - Deadline
  - Required Forms
- Watch for proposed priority listings—take advantage of public comment periods

# KEY PROGRAM QUESTIONS

- Who is eligible?
- When is the deadline?
- What is the CFDA number?
- What is the award amount per grant?
- How many projects will be funded?

- Is there a matching requirement?
- Where can I get the application?
- How and where do I submit the application?
- Is there a page limit?
- Who is the program contact?

# Establish a Timeline

- × Recipe: 2/3 planning and 1/3 writing
- Research program well in advance
- × Finalize any required partnerships
- Complete all necessary registrations
- Submit grant application <u>72 HOURS PRIOR TO</u> <u>DEADLINE</u>
- **×** Ensure application is *"REVIEWER FRIENDLY"*
