3 population with a prevalence of diabetes
4 that exceeds 15 percent, as determined by
5 the Director of the Indian Health Service.

6 On page 60, strike lines 24 and 25 and insert the
7 following:

8 “(C) USE OF FUNDS.—

9 “(i) IN GENERAL.—Funds made avail-
10 able under subparagraph (A) may be used
11 to

12 On page 61, between lines 5 and 6, insert the fol-
13 lowing:

14 “(ii) INDIAN RESERVATIONS.—Of
15 amounts made available under subpara-
16 graph (A), the Secretary shall use a por-
17 tion of the amounts to carry out research
18 relating to hunger, obesity and type 2 dia-
19 betes on Indian reservations, including re-
20 search to determine the manner in which
21 Federal nutrition programs can help to
22 overcome those problems.

1 “(iii) REPORT.—Not later than 1 year
2 after the date of enactment of this section,
3 the Secretary shall submit to the Com-
4 mittee on Agriculture of the House of Rep-
5 resentatives and the Committee on Agri-
6 culture, Nutrition, and Forestry of the
7 Senate a report that—

8 “(I) describes the manner in
9 which Federal nutrition programs can
10 help to overcome child hunger nutri-
11 tion problems on Indian reservations;
12 and

13 “(II) contains proposed adminis-
14 trative and legislative recommenda-
15 tions to strengthen and streamline all
16 relevant Department of Agriculture
17 nutrition programs to reduce child-
18 hood hunger, obesity, and type 2 dia-
19 betes on Indian reservations.
