Thank you for the swift action your Committee has taken in addressing the issue of the harmful and sometimes deadly use of restraint and seclusion in our nation's schools. As we have learned from many recent reports and the hearing held by your Committee on this issue, this is a widespread problem affecting thousands of defenseless schoolchildren annually. Unfortunately, students with disabilities are being subjected to these techniques in disproportionate numbers, often in the name of behavioral treatment. The use of these techniques is unacceptable under any circumstances.

To help address this issue, the National Center for Learning Disabilities (NCLD) is pleased to offer its support for H.R. 4247, the Preventing Harmful Restraint and Seclusion in Schools Act. We hope the bill can move quickly to passage.
