Service Academy Information: Timetable of Application Process, Eligibility Requirements and Selection Criteria

Timetable of Application Process

May 15, 2010

Request Nomination Application from the Fort Collins office (address below), or download from the website:

www.betsymarkey.house.gov

Students who reside in the Fourth Congressional District of Colorado and who are preparing to enter their senior year of high school may begin submitting application materials to request a Congressional nomination for a Service Academy.

A nomination from Representative Markey or one of your United States Senators from Colorado makes you eligible for an appointment to a U.S. Service Academy: the U.S. Air Force Academy, the U.S. Military Academy, the U.S. Naval Academy, and the U.S. Merchant Marine Academy. You should apply to both of your Senators as well as to Congresswoman Markey for a nomination.

September 24, 2010 Nomination Application Deadline

ALL applications and required materials MUST be postmarked or submitted online no later than **Friday**, **September 24**, **2010**. **No Exceptions Will Be Made**.

Applicants Are Responsible for Making Sure Their Files Are Complete.

If you do not submit the required information by the postmarked deadline, your application will not be considered.

October 29-30, 2010 Applicants will meet one-on-one with Congresswoman Markey's Academy Selection Board, which is composed of citizens selected from throughout the Fourth Congressional District and whose backgrounds and credentials qualify them to nominate the most qualified applicants.

> This thirty minute interview is mandatory for all applicants whose written applications show them to fully qualify for a nomination. The interviews will be held in the Fort Collins office and applicants will be notified of their interview time well in advance of the date.

The Academy Selection Board will also review each applicant's written materials, and they will make the decisions based on the "whole person" qualifications sought by the Academies: good moral character, a commendable academic record, evidence of strong leadership potential, physical aptitude, medical fitness, and motivation to achieve academically and eventually to serve as an officer in the Armed Forces.

December-January, 2010-11

Announcement of nominees: the Academy Selection Board will make its nominations and all nominees will be notified.

Beginning February, 2011

Offers of appointments from the Service Academies. A nomination by Congresswoman Markey DOES NOT automatically result in selection by the Military Service Academies.

Selection for Appointment to each Academy is Ultimately Decided upon by the Academy or Academies to which you have applied.

Service Academy Nomination Requirements

Applicants must meet the following requirements as of July 1st of the year of admission to an Academy:

1. Age	- The	applicant must	be between	17	and 22	vears old.
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- 2. Citizenship He/she must be a United States citizen by November 1st of the application year.
- 3. Marital Status He/she must be unmarried, not pregnant, and have no legal obligation to support children or other dependents.
- 4. Scholastic He/she shall have graduated from high school before July 1st of the year of entrance to an Academy.
- 5. Domicile He/she must reside in the Fourth Congressional District of Colorado.

Applicants must submit the following documents to the Congresswoman's Fort Collins office by: September 24, 2010:

- 1. Letter requesting nomination: Write a letter to Congresswoman Betsy Markey requesting she nominate you for an appointment in the academy or academies of your choice.
- 2. Application for Nomination: Return the COMPLETED application.
- 3. Resume: Provide a detailed listing of your academic honors, community service, athletic and other co-curricular activities, and other notable accomplishments. Please list these in order of importance to you.
- 4. Essays: There are two essay questions that are to be answered in no more than two pages each. Full instructions are given in the application itself.
- 5. Photo: Attach a recent color photo (2"x2") to your completed application.
- 6. Letters of recommendation: Submit two personal letters of recommendation from people who know you well but are not related to you. Such people might be teachers, employers, community leaders, church leaders, Scout/JROTC leaders, or other adults who know you well enough to assess your intellect, character and suitability for military service. These letters must either be sent directly to the Fort Collins office, which is preferable; or they may be given to you to include in your application materials. If you choose the latter, your recommenders must give their letters to you in sealed envelopes with their signature across the seal.

- 7. Counselor's form and letter of recommendation: Deliver the Counselor Form to your high school guidance counselor and have her/him send the completed form with their letter of recommendation directly to the Fort Collins office.
- 8. Official transcripts: Submit a copy of your official high school transcript to be sent directly from your high school (or college, if applicable) to the Fort Collins office. You must have every school you have attended in grades 9-12 send a transcript so that your entire high school academic record can be considered.
- 9. Standardized test results: Have you SAT and/or ACT scores sent directly from the testing services to the Fort Collins office. We must receive at least one official score by the September 24th deadline.

The selection of appointee is ultimately decided upon by the Academy to which you have applied. Nomination by Congresswoman Betsy Markey does not automatically result in selection by the Military Service Academies.
