Senator Gregg: With Democratic Pay-Go, Actions Speak Louder Than Words
Pay-Go Amendment to Debt Limit Bill is Disingenuous at Best

Senator Judd Gregg (R-NH), ranking member of the Senate Budget Committee, today stated his opposition to the version of Pay-Go that the Democratic majority is attempting to attach to the debt limit bill.

"Like a worn-out pair of shoes trotted out once too often, the Democrats' Pay-Go amendment is full of holes. It would allow a significant number of exemptions that make it ripe for gimmickry and waivers, adding to the debt it is supposed to avoid.
