**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 3717, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. UPTON**

Manager's amendment

In subsection (d) of section 503 of the Communications Act of 1934, as added by section 7 of the bill, strike paragraph (2) and insert the following:

1 “(2) a court of competent jurisdiction has or-
2 dered payment of such forfeiture penalty, and such
3 order has become final,

In the matter that follows paragraph (2) of section 503(d) of the Communications Act of 1934, as added by section 7 of the bill, strike “, notwithstanding section 504(e),”.

In paragraph (5) of section 309(k) of the Communications Act of 1934, as added by section 8 of the bill, strike subparagraph (B) and insert the following:

4 “(B) a court of competent jurisdiction has
5 ordered payment of such forfeiture penalty, and
6 such order has become final,

In the matter that follows subparagraph (B) of section 309(k)(5) of the Communications Act of 1934, as



added by section 8 of the bill, strike “, notwithstanding section 504(c),”.

In paragraph (1) of section 312(h) of the Communications Act of 1934, as added by section 9 of the bill, strike subparagraph (B) and insert the following:

1 “(B) a court of competent jurisdiction has
2 ordered payment of such forfeiture penalty, and
3 such order has become final,

In the matter that follows subparagraph (B) of section 312(h)(1) of the Communications Act of 1934, as added by section 9 of the bill, strike “, notwithstanding section 504(c),”.

In section 10, insert “and” at the end of subparagraph (C) of paragraph (7), strike “; and” at the end of subparagraph (D) of such paragraph and insert a period, strike subparagraph (E) of such paragraph, and after such paragraph insert the following new paragraphs:

4 (8) In instances where the licensee has refused
5 to pay, whether the Commission referred such order
6 to the Department of Justice to collect the penalty.

7 (9) In cases where the Commission referred
8 such order to the Department of Justice—

9 (A) the number of days from the date the
10 Commission issued such order to the date the



1 Commission referred such order to the Depart-
2 ment;

3 (B) whether the Department has com-
4 menced an action to collect the penalty, and if
5 such action was commenced, the number of
6 days from the date the Commission referred
7 such order to the Department to the date the
8 action by the Department commenced; and

9 (C) whether the collection action resulted
10 in a payment, and if such action resulted in a
11 payment, the amount of such payment.
