Purpose of the project and why it is a good use of taxpayer funds: The funding would be used for supporting the nationally significant anti-sexual assault initiatives that are authorized by section 628 of the Adam Walsh Child Protection and Safety Act (P.L. 109-248) at \$3 million annually. These include two national hotlines for sexual assault victims, the National Sexual Assault Online Hotline (rainn.org) and the National Sexual Assault [Telephone] Hotline (800-656-HOPE); and RAINN's public education and outreach programs, such as RAINN Day (a peer education program currently active on college campuses nationwide)
