Purpose of the project and why it is a good use of taxpayer funds: The funding would be used for strengthening their Real Jobs -Training Tomorrow's Women Entrepreneurs Program, which supports their Farmers' Market; Sweet Things Bake Shop and Cafe; Celebrate, a Coffee Shop/Café; and La Tiendita Gift Shop. Through the hands-on management and operation of these facilities, girls learn a myriad of life skills to take with them into adulthood: valuable time-management skills, customer relations habits, and the understanding of such small business survival skills as marketing, cost of inputs, and profit and loss.
