Whether you're new to the neighborhood, or if you've lived here for a while but hadn't registered to vote until recently, I want to introduce myself and let you know of the services available to you. I represent you, and the rest of the 14th District in Congress—which now includes you, according to the Board of Elections.

**Since first coming to Congress in 1993, I've built a record in Washington on issues of importance** including financial services, government oversight and efficiency, women's rights, and foreign policy. I now serve on two House Committees, Financial Services and Government Oversight and Reform, and I'm proud to have been appointed Chair of the Congressional Joint Economic Committee.

**In addition to my legislative activity, I've worked to bring Federal dollars and attention to the 14th District.** Recent successes have included the Dept. of Transportation's funding to study the East Side Connector project (which would link the LIRR with Grand Central Station via a tunnel underneath the East River) and funding for completion of the Second Avenue Subway now underway.

**Just as important, though, is serving the constituents of the 14th District.** My staff and I can assist you with issues you may have with a government agency: such as difficulties with student or FHA loans, Social Security problems, Medicare, the IRS—even postal delivery.
