Dear Mr. President,

We are writing to urge you to meet with the Ecumenical Patriarchate when you visit Turkey in April.

The Ecumenical Patriarchate, located in Istanbul, Turkey, is the spiritual home of the world's oldest and second largest Christian Church. One of the world's preeminent spiritual leaders representing more than 300 million Orthodox Christians worldwide, the Ecumenical Patriarchate has worked for peace and reconciliation amongst all faiths. In 1997, Congress acted to bestow its highest honor, the Congressional Gold Medal, on Ecumenical Patriarch Bartholomew.

We are concerned that Turkey has yet to recognize the Ecumenical Patriarchate's international status, has limited to Turkish nationals the candidates available to the Holy Synod of the Greek Orthodox Church for selection as the Ecumenical Patriarchate, and has failed to reopen the Theological School at Halki. We believe that your visit with Ecumenical Patriarch Bartholomew, as President Clinton's visit did during his presidency, would signal the ongoing commitment of the United States to religious freedom.
