- **Deadline for Entries: Monday, May 3, 2010**

Entries are due at the participating high school, or the Boulder Congressional Office, located at 4770 Baseline Road, #220, in Boulder before 5pm. No exceptions will be made, so please prepare to submit your work on time! Entries must be accompanied by your completed "Student Information and Release Form." Remember to have your parent/guardian and your art teacher sign this form. **Artwork must be ready to hang.**

- **Congressional Art Show Exhibition: TBD**

Student artwork will be displayed at a location to be determined for at least two weeks. We invite all students, families, teachers and the general public to view this celebration of the great artistic talent of our local high school students.

- **Art Show Reception: TBD**

Congressman Jared Polis will announce the winner of *An Artistic Discovery* at a special reception with a location and date to be determined. The winner, chosen by a special judging committee selected by the Congressman will be announced. Participants and their families as well as teachers are encouraged to attend.

- **Exhibition Opening in Washington D.C.: June 17, 2010**

Each year, General Motors sponsors a special celebratory reception for the unveiling of the student artwork from all across the nation. Invitations will be sent to members of Congress and each winning student. The winning student will have a chance to visit Congressman Jared Polis in Washington, D.C.
