3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Keep Out the IRS Act5 of 2010".

SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON HIRING ADDITIONAL IRS EMPLOY EES TO IMPLEMENT, ADMINISTER, OR EN FORCE HEALTH INSURANCE REFORM.

4 No position within the Internal Revenue Service may be filled, by transfer or any other appointment taking ef-5 6 fect on or after the date of enactment of this Act, if the duties and responsibilities of such position include the im-7 8 plementation, administration, or enforcement of any provision of, or amendment made by, the Patient Protection 9 and Affordable Care Act or the Health Care and Edu-10 cation Reconciliation Act of 2010. 11
