- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. TREATMENT OF OIL SHALE RESERVE RE-
- 4 CEIPTS.
- 5 Section 7439(f) of title 10, United States Code, is
- 6 amended by adding at the end the following:
- 7 "(3)(A) The moneys deposited in the Treasury under
- 8 paragraph (1) that exceed the amounts described in sub-
- 9 paragraphs (A) and (B) of paragraph (2) shall be trans-

- 1 ferred by the Secretary of the Treasury in accordance with
- 2 section 35 of the Mineral Leasing Act (30 U.S.C. 191)
- 3 to the State of Colorado for use in accordance with sub-
- 4 paragraph (B).
- 5 "(B) Amounts transferred to the State of Colorado
- 6 under subparagraph (A) shall be used by the State and
- 7 political subdivisions of the State for—
- 8 "(i) conservation, restoration, and protection of
- 9 land, water, and wildlife resources affected by oil or
- gas development activities in Garfield and Rio Blan-
- 11 co Counties in the State;
- 12 "(ii) repair, maintenance, and construction of
- 13 State and county roads in each of those counties;
- 14 and
- 15 "(iii) the conduct of capital improvement
- projects (including the construction and maintenance
- of sewer and water treatment plants) that are de-
- signed and carried out to address the impacts of oil
- and gas development activities in each of those coun-
- 20 ties.".
