- 30 And the clerk will report the bill, please.
- 31 The Clerk. H.R. 1741, a bill to require the attorney
- 32 general to make competitive grants to eligible state, tribal
- 33 and local prosecutors to establish and maintain certain
- 34 protection and witness assistance programs.

- 39 You will recall, last week, we had adopted Chairman
- 40 Bobby Scott's substitute amendment and had moved to report
- 41 the bill, but we suspended because of lack of a reporting
- 42 quorum.
- 43 Mr. Scott. Mr. Chairman?
- Chairman Convers. Yes, Mr. Scott?
- 45 Mr. Scott. Mr. Chairman, I think we were in the middle
- 46 of a roll call vote on that, and I would ask unanimous
- 47 consent that that roll call vote be vitiated.
- 48 Chairman Convers. Without objection, so ordered.
- 49 A reporting quorum being present, we will now vote on
- 50 the bill, as amended, favorably to the House.
- 51 All in favor, say "aye."
