



The Savannah College of Art and Design is pleased to recognize the Congressional Arts Competition as one of its select recognized national programs honoring the talents and abilities of students at the high school level. Your program is important in providing support and encouragement for talented young students.

Students selected as district first place winners in the 2010 Congressional Arts Competition may be eligible to receive a \$1,500 per year admission scholarship to SCAD, should they apply and be accepted. Accepted students may be eligible for additional admission scholarships based on GPA and SAT or ACT scores, portfolio submission, audition or writing submission. Scholarships are limited and are awarded to the earliest qualifiers. Students entering in the fall are encouraged to apply and submit required scholarship materials by Feb. 15.

Students may also be eligible for scholarships from alternative sources and funding from a variety of lending institutions. United States citizens and resident aliens may be eligible for applicable federal and state aid.
