UNITED STATES SERVICE ACADEMY CHECKLIST

To be considered for a nomination to one of the United States Service Academies by Congressman Marsha Blackburn, your packet must be received by the Franklin, Tennessee office by October 31, 2010. Your completed file must contain the following:

1. **Completed Application Form**
2. **High School Transcript** – Your transcript must include all course work, GPA, and class rank.
3. **Standardized Test Scores** – Please provide scores from the ACT or SAT, or both.
4. **Community & School Activity List** – Please list all school, athletic, and community activities and other significant accomplishments/awards.
5. **Letters of Recommendation** – Please provide four letters of recommendation.
6. **Essay** – Please provide a 500 word essay outlining why you want to attend a United States Service Academy.
7. **Interview** – All applicants will be required to attend one interview session during the months of November and December. Dates, times, and locations will be determined at a later date.
8. **Photograph** – (OPTIONAL).
9. **Deadline** – Send the above information by ***October 31, 2010***:
