Application for Nomination to the United States Armed Services Academies

1. **APPLICATION FORM** – must be completed and signed by applicant. This must be typed or legibly written. Formal candidacy can only be established upon the receipt of a completed application by the Augusta District office. It is the responsibility of each applicant to initiate a pre-candidate file at each academy to which they are seeking a nomination.
2. **PERSONAL RECOMMENDATION FORMS** – candidates must submit three (3) Personal Recommendation Forms completed by counselors, principals, teachers, religious leaders (i.e. priests, rabbis, and ministers), coaches, or community leaders. Candidates are required to return a minimum of three (3) Personal Recommendation Forms by the deadline; these forms may be accompanied by written letters of recommendation. Letters in excess of this number will not be reviewed. All references should be from non-family members.
3. **ACADEMIC TRANSCRIPT** – The official transcript must be in a sealed envelope with a signature across the seal. If a candidate has already graduated from high school, in addition to a transcript, information outlining the candidate's academic and/or employment activities since graduation should also be included.
4. **CURRENT PHOTOGRAPH** – please submit a wallet size photo with name and hometown written on the back.
5. **STANDARDIZED TEST RESULTS** – Please include ACT and/or SAT scores in the application packet. Scores that appear on a sealed transcript or in a sealed envelope from a guidance counselor will be accepted. SAT Code - 5984 ACT Code – 7360
6. **CANDIDATE FITNESS TEST** – Please provide a copy of a completed CFT. A form is available from the academies and the examination is to be administered by a high school coach or physical education teacher. This is optional as some academies do not provide this information.

Deadline – Completed application packets must be received in the Augusta office by October 15, 2010. No exceptions. Send all requested information to:

Please answer the SPECIFIC QUESTIONS asked on this form, and use additional pages if necessary. You are welcome to submit a recommendation letter; however, it will not be accepted as a substitute for this completed form.

2. Describe the applicant's talents, strengths, and leadership ability.
3. How could this applicant improve in order to rise to the challenges presented by a U.S. service academy?
4. Do you believe the applicant plans to pursue military service as a career? Does he/she possess the maturity to fulfill the commitments and obligations that accompany a service academy education?
5. How does the applicant handle challenging situations and/or failures?
6. Do you know of any personal circumstances that might affect the applicant's performance at a service academy?
