• On Thursday, the Subcommittee on National Parks, Forests and Public Lands will hold an oversight hearing on "The Role of Partnerships in National Parks." The National Park Service has a long history of partnering with public and private entities to help acquire land, build visitor centers and other facilities, protect resources, expand scientific research, and reach out to new constituencies. Over the years, parks throughout the system have become increasingly dependent on their public and private partners. The Subcommittee will receive testimony on the benefits and risks of these partnerships within the National Park Service.
