Guidelines

WHO: Open exclusively to high school students currently in grades 9-12. To be eligible to win, student must

be a resident of, or attend high school in, the 5th Congressional District. *Each teacher may submit to the competition up to 2 two-dimensional pieces of student art (not larger than 28"x28" including*

frame) that meet the enclosed guidelines

WHAT: 2010 Congressional Art Competition initiated by members of the U.S. House of Representatives

WHY: "An Artistic Discovery" provides Congress and the public the opportunity to encourage and

recognize the rich artistic talents of young Americans

MEDIUM: Entries must be flat and two-dimensional. Entries must be original, no larger than 28" high x28"wide

x 4"deep including the frame, and cannot weigh more than 15 lbs. Artwork categories are as follows:

Paintings: oil, acrylics, watercolor, etc.

• **Drawings**: pastels, colored pencil, pencil, charcoal, ink, markers

Collage: collages must be two-dimensionalPrints: lithographs, silkscreen, block prints

Mixed media: use of more than 2 mediums such as pencil, ink, etc.

• Computer-generated art

TIMELINE: March 31: Artwork, Label, and TYPED Student Release Form signed by both student and

teacher must be received at PCAE. Artwork received after March 31 will not be considered

April 5: 5th Congressional District **Student Art Exhibition** opens at PCAE

May 3: Congressman Ellison hosts **Arts Forum, Reception, & Awards Ceremony** at PCAE

May 24: Winning piece of art is due in Washington, D.C. The 1st -place winner will be

displayed with other congressional district winners around the nation

June 17: 1st place winner is invited to Washington, D.C. for Ribbon-Cutting Ceremony

JUDGING CRITERIA: 1. Originality

2. Clearly expressed content

3. Not reproduced from a 3rd party's work

4. Not a violation of U.S. copyright laws
