H.R. 3787, as amended The Honor America's Guard-Reserve Retirees Act

Title: To amend title 38, United States Code, to recognize the service in the reserve components of certain persons by honoring them with status as veterans under law.

Mr. Walz introduced H.R. 3787 on October 8, 2009.

H.R. 3787, as amended, would:

- Recognize retirees of the National Guard and Reserve as veterans for honorary purposes only.
- Exclude these individuals from receiving any additional benefits by virtue of addition of this section under title 38.
