

I am requesting \$11,900,000.00 for a large Fire Crash Rescue Station at Travis Air Force Base in Fairfield California. The entity to receive funding for this project is Travis Air Force Base in Fairfield California.

The current fire station at Travis AFB is a 45-year old deteriorated facility. The station does not support the 65 personnel and 14 vehicles assigned to it. The location does not provide direct access to runways, ramps, and flightline facilities. The facility does not meet minimum response to meet fire codes and standards and current station is also seismically-deficient.

This project would provide a properly located, sized, and configured Large Fire Crash Rescue Station; station that will house all fire fighting equipment and crews of the central station; a central fire alarm system, command and control; quarters for 24-hour crews; and demolition of a 1,527 SM building.

Authorization to fund this project was included in the FY07 Defense Authorization Act. Additionally, the Senate Appropriations Committee approved full funding for this project. Due to the funding constraints of the FY07 Continuing Resolution, final funding of the Large Fire Crash Rescue Station was not approved. This project remains the base's number one unfunded priority for FY09.
