On April 20, 2010, an explosion occurred on a semisubmersible drilling rig off the Gulf of Mexico. The oil rig is operated by Transocean Ltd. under contract with BP Exploration and Production, Inc. According to BP's public statement, at the time of the explosion 126 crew members were on board, and some remain unaccounted for.
